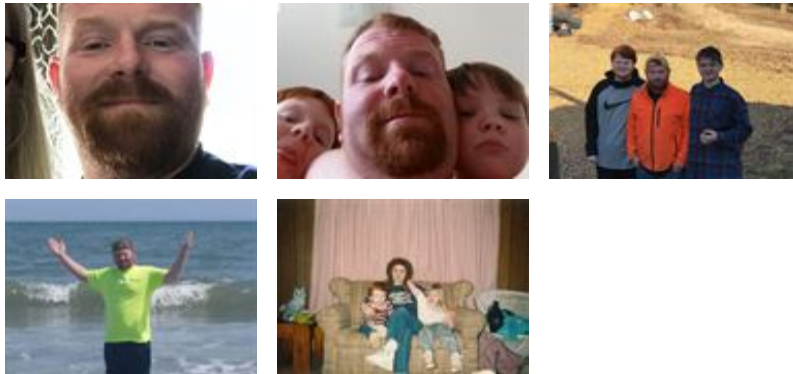

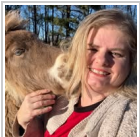
“ Brad was a hard worker would help you do anything you asked I worked with him on the farm he will be missed but not for gotten always had you laughing and he had a good heart rip my friend
