Brian "Bart" McGuire, age 52, passed away on Saturday, June 22, 2024, in Germantown, TN. In his current role, Bart was an expert on US FedEx operations. His extensive experience, from handling to management and training, made him a true expert in the field. Bart led a team of experts to develop and refine standard operating procedures for courier station operations. He was originally hired on March 12, 1991, as a handler/tug driver and lastly as Operations Technical Advisor; celebrating 33 years with FedEx on June 23, 2024. Throughout his career, Bart received numerous awards, including many Bravo Zulu awards for outstanding performance beyond normal job expectations. He made a lasting impact, improving every position he held.
