“ Uncle Chris,

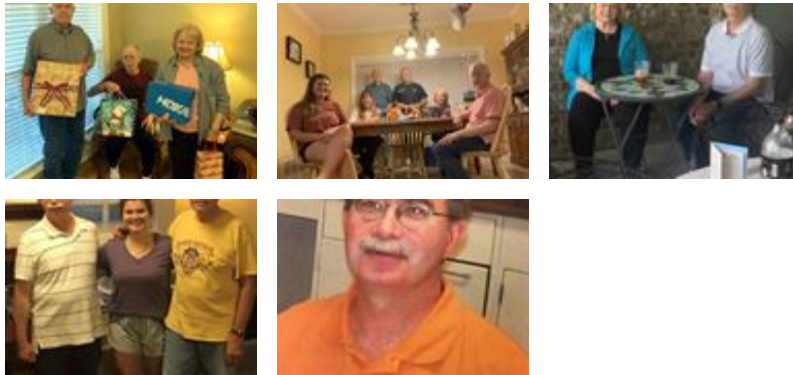

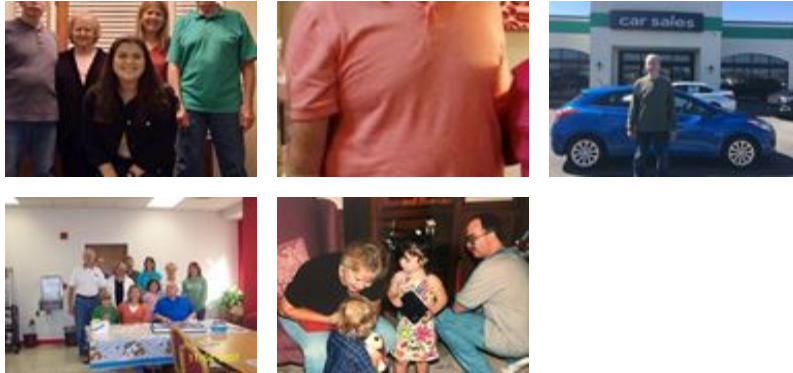
