Clifford "Cliff" Dean Nentwig, 73, of Cockrum, MS, passed away on Saturday, April 22, 2023. Cliff loved any excuse to be outdoors. He owned about five acres of land that he called his "farm," where he raised chickens and cats. always available and willing to help anyone in need. Cliff was a kind and generous man who will be missed greatly.
