Afterwards, he continued to serve in the United States Postal Service in Shreveport, Louisiana for thirty-five years. He started out as a clerk and retired as a station manager. Coleman was also a part of the construction crew for R. A. Mackey Real Estate building houses and maintaining properties.

Coleman married Rosa Lee Marsh on April 6, 1947 in Shreveport, LA. They lived in Shreveport, LA for many years. While there, he was a faithful member of Life Tabernacle where he also served on the board. In 1994, they moved to Olive Branch, MS and became founding members at Rejoice Church where he served on the board of directors as Treasurer for twenty years. He was

Later, Coleman moved to Duncanville, TX to live with Linda and Dalton in 2018. There he attended Mountain Creek Community Church.

In his spare time, Coleman loved bowling and fishing. He bought three houses that he remodeled, added onto, and then sold for a profit. He may have been the original "Fixer Upper". He was smart with finances, tools, and he was organized!!!
