Mrs. Brignac was preceded in death by her parents, Irvin Louis Landry and

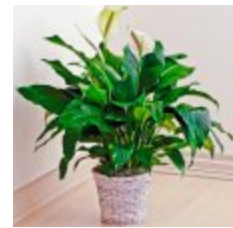
Harriet Mae Gomez Landry; and one grandchild, Kaiden Rodriguez.
