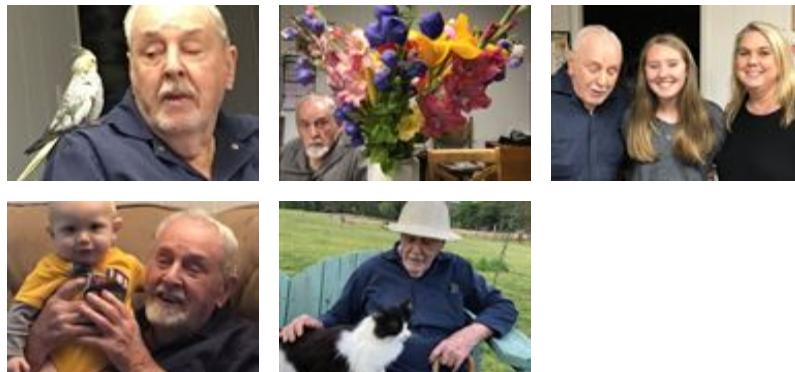
“ He was the perfect example of a Great Uncle, I was so Blessed to have been his niece.

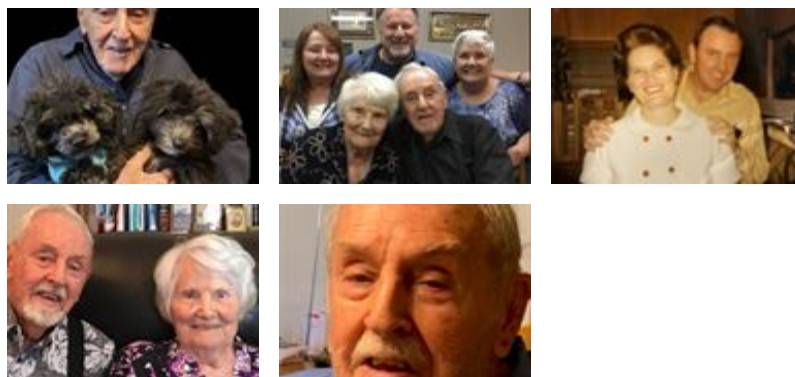
