Mr. George E. "Ed" Cade, 67, passed away at his home in Oxford, MS on Monday, August 7, 2023. A private service celebrating Ed's life will be held for family and friends at a later date. Coleman Funeral Home of Oxford is in charge of local arrangements.

George, best known by his loved ones and friends as Ed, was welcomed into this world on December 20, 1955 in West Point, MS to the late William and Frances Cade.

Brooksville, MS, and Mary Tait (Bryan) of Collierville, TN; as well as many special nieces, nephews, and cousins.
