Mr. George Andrew Harrigan III, 74, died Wednesday, September 14, 2016 at Baptist Memorial Hospital- Southaven, MS.

Born in Ipswich, MA, Mr. Harrigan had lived in Olive Branch, MS for most of his life. He was a United States Marine Corps veteran of 10 years, also having served in the Vietnam War. He was also a past commander at the A.P. Gardner Post 194 located in Massachusetts, where he was the first Vietnam veteran to join the post.
