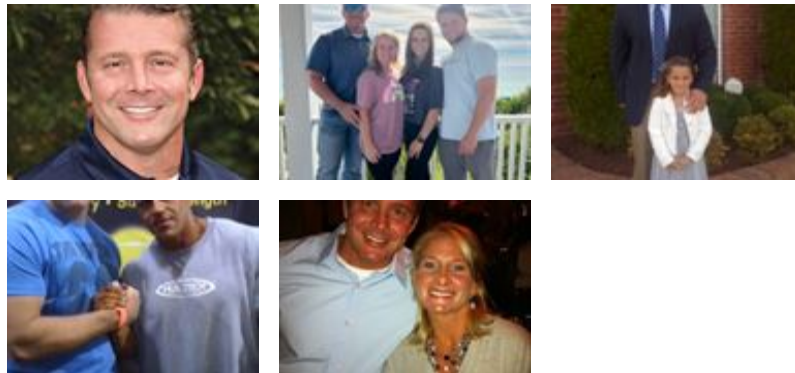


Dano really helped me after my knee replacement. It is surreal that someone as physically fit as he was is now gone. He will be missed. My condolences to his family
