Harold Lee Greer, 81, of Hernando, MS, died December 30, 2022 at Baptist Memorial Hospital-Desoto, surrounded by his family.

Harold was the first-born of 8 children, to the late Sherman Lee Greer and Lottie Mildred Anderson Greer, an army veteran and farmer and a homemaker, respectively. He was born at Baptist Hospital in Memphis, TN on September 22, 1941.
