Mr. Homer Vernon Harris, 79, passed away at Baptist Memorial Hospital, Oxford, MS, on Wednesday, November 11, 2020. 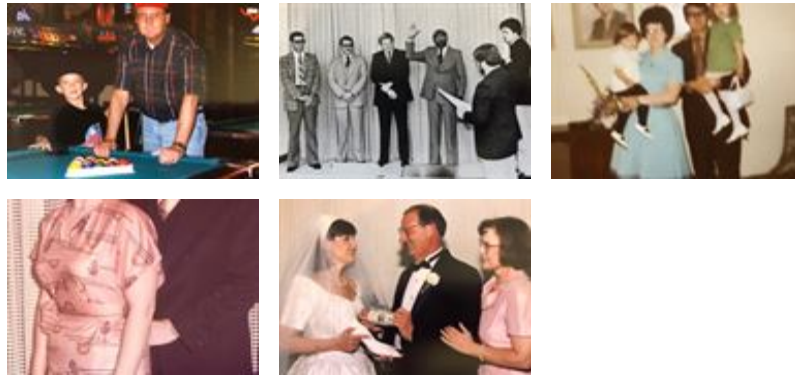

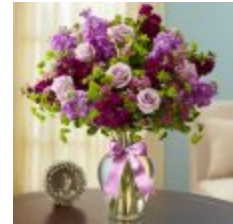
