Janice was preceded in death by her parents, Neely and Bertha Scott; her siblings Floy McGarrh (Jim), William Scott, Mary "Sissy" Scott, Lloyd Scott (Margie), Gladys Faye Wing (Maurice), and Roy Scott; and her grandsons, Joseph Taylor and Jaden Taylor.

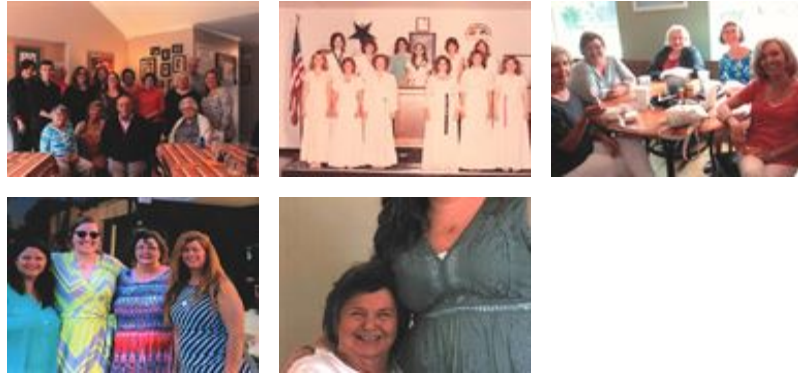
