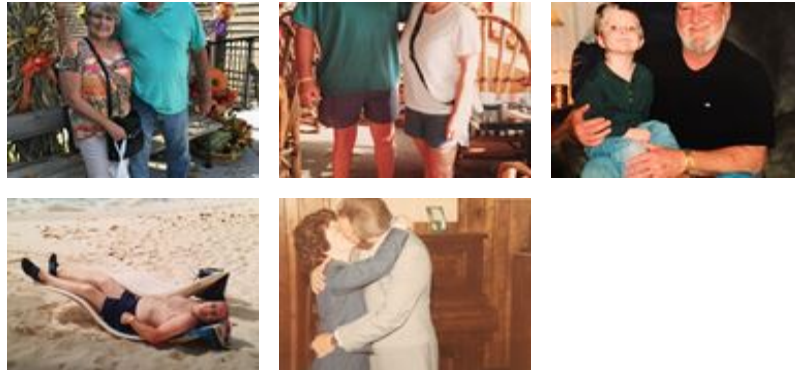
I especially remember the times he and I shared eating our favorite health food, Captain D's. He always made me laugh and I will greatly miss him.
