Jewell Wayne Halley, age 75, died Saturday, September 5, 2009, at the State Veterans Home in Oxford, MS.

Born in Memphis, TN, he had moved to the Mt. Pleasant, MS, area in 1978. Mr. Halley retired from the U.S. Army in 1976 after serving 21 years. During his military career, he had served in Korea. He helped procure land for the Marshall County Humane Society and was instrumental in starting the volunteer fire department in his community.
