Mr. Joe Mack Brown, 45, passed away August 26, 2021, at Baptist Memorial Hospital in Memphis, TN. Joe supported and loved his coworkers and deemed them as his work family. Always willing to spend a moment caring for them, regardless of his own

needs or energy levels. Even in Joe's death his generosity was fully displayed, through organ and tissue donation. In the final act of his life he made a decision which saved one person's life and helped over 100 other individuals, all of whom were strangers to him.

Mr. Brown is survived by his sister, Jeri (Vicente) Leyva of Horn Lake, MS; one niece, Lucia (Alex) Garivey of Horn Lake; three nephews, Sonny (Nicole) Leyva, Ricky (Brittney) Leyva, and Manny Leyva, all of Horn Lake; one step-sister, Dondi Jayroe of Lubbock; one step-brother, Terry (Suzie) Crews of Lubbock; 8 great-nieces and great-nephews; and one great-nephew on the way.
