John Horace Caldwell, 84, died Monday, October 16, 2006, at Baptist Memorial Hospital-NM, Oxford, MS.

Mr. Caldwell had lived in Jackson, MS, most of his life, but had moved to Oxford from Biloxi, MS, as a result of Hurricane Katrina in December 2005. He was a WWII veteran of the U.S. Navy Armed Guard. Mr. Caldwell was employed as an engineer for BellSouth from 1946-1991. He was a member of the BellSouth Pioneers. He was formerly active in several Tupelo and Jackson area United Methodist churches in youth activities and in Sunday school.
