John also had a great love for the outdoors, a love that was passed down from his father, Steve. John enjoyed spending every second he could being outdoors with his son and his father. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, and competing in archery tournaments, as he was a Pro Staff Shooter for Elite Archery as well. John loved to be on the go, and you would never see him sitting still, he was either in the woods or creating memories with his beloved family and friends. John not only served his country, but he also served his Lord and Savior well through his kind heart and loving soul. John loved his family so dearly, and he has created a legacy where he will remain in the hearts of every person who felt the depth of his love. John will truly be missed by all who knew him.

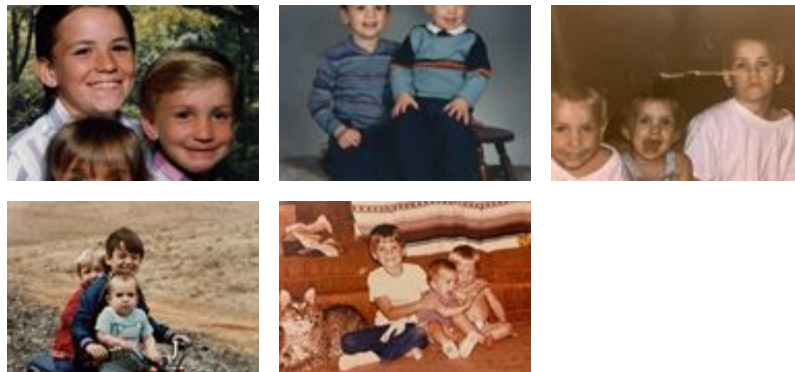
