Above all, Johnny loved his family dearly and enjoyed being a brother, an uncle, a cousin, and a friend. He made your life better just

because he was in it. He will definitely be missed by all that knew him.

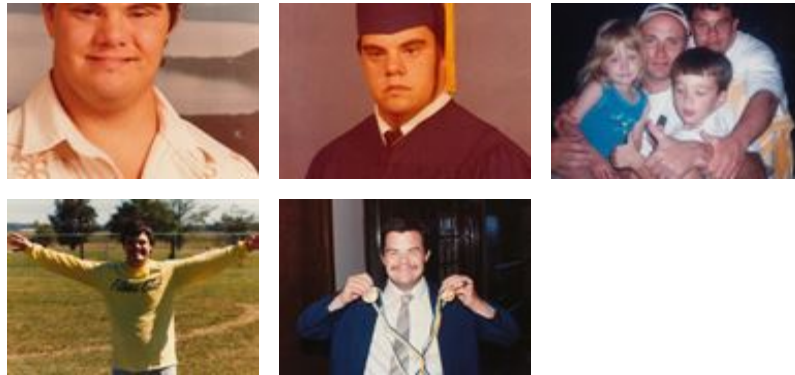
