He tried hard to overcome it but could not find his way out, despite receiving help from family, friends, psychiatrists, and counselors. Jonah was loved by many and will be truly missed by all who knew him.

I wish I could give you the biggest hug I can give people and tell you how much I care about you. Listen, when I'm not available, try NOT to get into a load of trouble you can't get yourself out of? 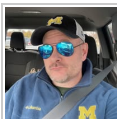

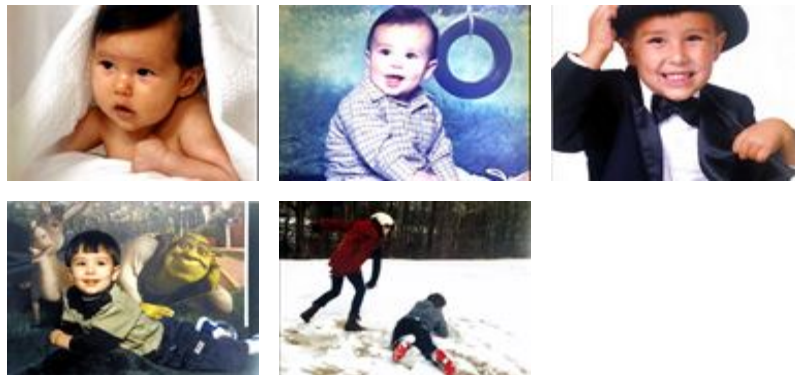
