Judith (Judy) Martinez, 81, died Sunday, October 29, 2023, at Oxford Health & Rehab Center in Oxford, MS. Judy was born in Hartsville, TN to Edith Wright and Charles Lee Burton. Judy attended Tennessee Tech and studied music, and would later complete a Bachelor of Arts from Tulane University in New Orleans, LA. Judy worked in sales for a national insurance company in New Orleans, and moved to Oxford in 2005 after Hurricane Katrina. Judy was known for her musical talents and singing, and she offered these gifts in her parish communities—Church of the Holy Comforter (New Orleans) and St. Peter's Episcopal Church (Oxford). She was also involved in music in the Oxford community through her involvement with a dulcimer group at Peace Lutheran Church. Judy volunteered in St. Peter's outreach ministries at North Mississippi Regional Center and Elison Assisted Living, playing music for residents. She is also remembered for her kindness to animals; she volunteered with a visiting pets program for nursing home residents in New Orleans and was a faithful supporter of 9 Lives Cat Rescue in Oxford.

Along with her parents, Judy was preceded in death by her sister, Linda Elaine Rogers; her step-father, Jesse Littleton Rogers; and her cherished companion of 25 years, Kenneth Alva Stead. She is survived by her many loving friends and her former husband and friend, George Martinez of Atlanta,

GA.
