While her job title may have been Elementary Teacher, Laura was much more. Laura founded Oak Hill Stables and nurtured its many riding students, young and old, since 1978. She helped several generations fulfill their passion for riding horses and the outdoors. In 2007 Laura created the Oak Hill Stables Bed and Breakfast. She graciously opened her home to host many weddings and out of town guests. Laura was a larger than life figure in Oxford. She will be greatly missed.

A funeral service to honor Laura will be held at St. Peters Episcopal Church at 10:00am August 21, 2021. She has requested that her remains be interred next to her beloved Charlie at St. Peter's columbarium. A reception will be held immediately after the service in the Parish hall of the church.
