Mrs. Marilee M. Robertson, 82, passed away at her residence in Memphis, TN, on Friday, January 5, 2018. She enjoyed working with them and guiding them through every step of the home buying process.

Mrs. Robertson will be remembered as someone who loved everyone – if you knew her, you know she loved to love on people. She cherished the time spent with her family and her extended family, her neighbors. All would remember to visit her around the holidays, especially Halloween for her special goodie-bags and Christmas to see her decorations. Mrs. Robertson

was one to decorate for her favorite holiday, Christmas, even the bathrooms! She had over 80 boxes with items to put out on display each year. She was often referred to as “a kid at heart” by her mother and others in our family and that was shown by how she decorated and spent time with others during the holidays.

Aside from the holidays, one would be able to find Mrs. Robertson in her yard, tending to her flowers (varying shades of blues with daylilies and irises). Each thumb was green and everyone knew it as she was often asked to help bring back family plants and neighborhood greenery throughout the years.

Mrs. Robertson was also a teacher. She taught her children and grandchildren many important things throughout her time with them. She grew peanuts and cotton just so her children could see how things go from a seed to a fully grown plant. The family had a caterpillar one time and gave it a home in the jar with leaves and other items needed to grow. Mrs. Robertson had each of the children watch it grow and mature into a butterfly. Mrs. Robertson taught all of her children to read and write before they were in school. The greatest thing she taught her family was how to love others – not just their own siblings or relatives, but everyone. She will be remembered for that great quality.

Mrs. Robertson leaves behind her sons, Thomas (Sharon) Robertson of Issaquah, WA, and John Robertson of Chattanooga, TN; daughter, Adrienne (Rocky) Murphy of Olive Branch, MS; nephew, Mike Montgomery of Jackson, MS; 7 grandchildren, Ashley (Mike), Chris, Amanda, Tyler, Rhys, Michael, and McKenna; 4 great-grandchildren, Hunter, Maggie, Cam, and Jonathan; and a host of high school classmates and lifelong friends.

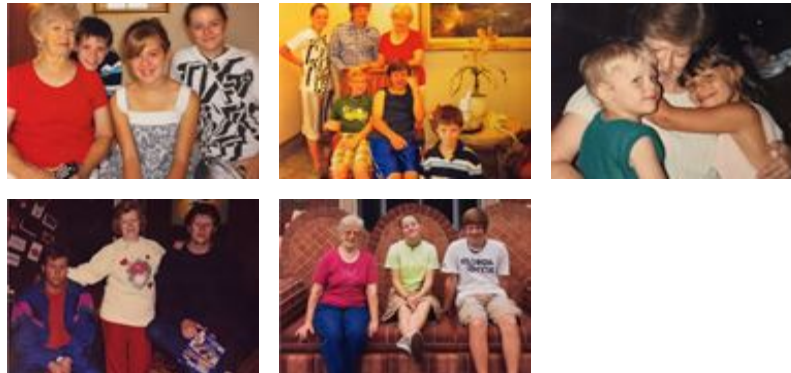
