Out of high school, Mr. Mark worked as a riverboat captain and drove the Charlie E. for Waterways Marina where he saved the lives of at least two people on different occasions as well as a dog in the Mississippi river. He also became a painting contractor for Richards Brothers, where he dedicated over 20 years of work.

Mr. Mark had quite a sense of humor and the ability to make an impression on the lives of nearly every person he met. He will truly be missed by all who knew him.

Mr. Mark is survived by his beloved wife, Stacey Schingle of Walls; two sons, William "Tyler" Schingle of Mobile, AL, and Nash A. Schingle of Walls; two sisters, Susan Cohn and Kathy Mitchell, both of Memphis; and four nephews, Stan Mitchell, Adam Mitchell, Jason Mitchell, and Matthew Cohn. 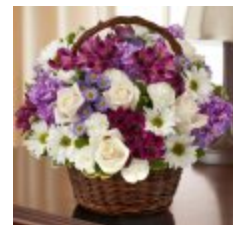

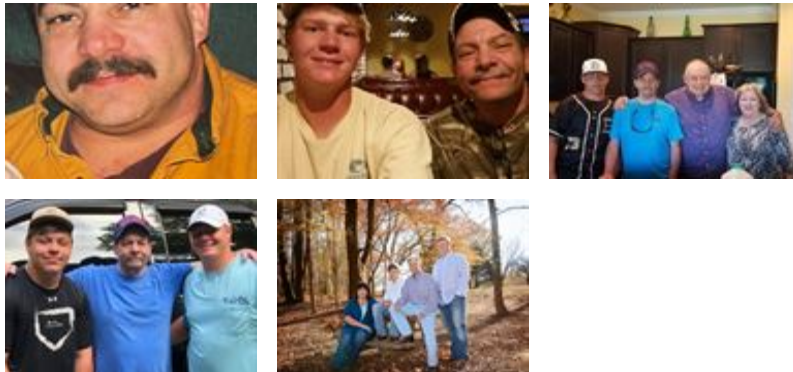
