She was always " headstrong" and would sometimes take a spanking instead of saying I'm sorry. Things were tough in the early 40's and we moved into a small farmhouse in 1944 in Mershon, Ga. with our Brewton grandparents while Dad was in the pacific with the army. I'm talking out house, no electricity,no car type TOUGH. It made us both stronger.

After WWII we moved back to Savannah, Ga., and were fortunate enough to have a GOD fearing mother who took us to a Bible believing church and were led to the LORD.

If Marlene was your friend, she always had your back. When she was 15, I moved on to Sr. college and Med. school and was not around her much. She fell in love with a flashy A.F. man with a Cadillac convertible and married at 17.
