Michael Roy Loveland, 74, passed away on January 29, 2021, at his home surrounded by his loving family.

Mr. Loveland was a Vietnam War veteran, who received a bronze star for his exceptional service and courage in the face of combat. In addition, he received a letter from President Donald Trump thanking him for his brave and honorable service. His willingness for personal duty was extended to his fellow veterans, as he was presented a certificate from the Community of Heroes, for his spirit of sacrifice and demonstrated devotion to all fellow veterans.

Michael's patriotic service to the United States never ended. He was a Lifetime member of Oath Keepers; Pup Tent 6 and Military Order of Cooties - State MS Chapter Leader; VFW Post 10567 Lifetime Member; Grand Commander of Veterans of Foreign Wars State of MS; a member of the National Rifle Association of America; and an Honorary Desoto County Sheriff's Deputy where he worked with a K9 Unit.

Mr. Loveland showed the same dedication to his family, that he did his country, as he was a devoted husband, loving father, brother, and grandfather.

Mr. Michael Loveland is survived by his beloved wife, Janet Loveland of Southaven; his three daughters, Miranda Loveland of Olive Branch, MS, Michelle Klumpenhower (David) of Elkhart, IN, and Stephanie Watson (Michael) of Paducah, KY; his two sons Michael Loveland (Holly) of Olive Branch, and Phillip Pounders (Brianne) of Como, MS; his brother, Steve Loveland (Dannielle) of Elkhart; three grandsons, Joshua Sargent (A.J.) of Elkhart, Lane Loveland of Olive Branch, and Devin Loveland of Olive Branch; three granddaughters, Jordan Loveland of Olive Branch, Liberty Grace Watson of Paducah, and Jade Buckingham of Olive Branch; three great-granddaughters, Faye Sargent, Winnifred "Winn" Sargent, and Allyria Sargent, all of Elkhart, IN.

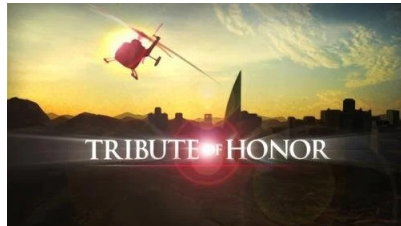

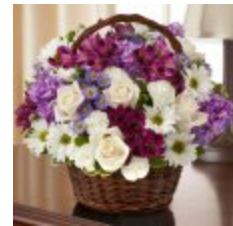
