God had already came to me a few weeks ago to prepare me for something that was going to impact my life. I just didn't know it was going to be this.

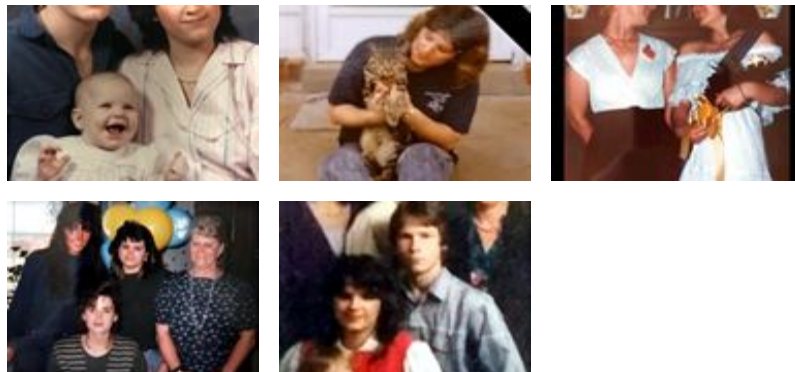

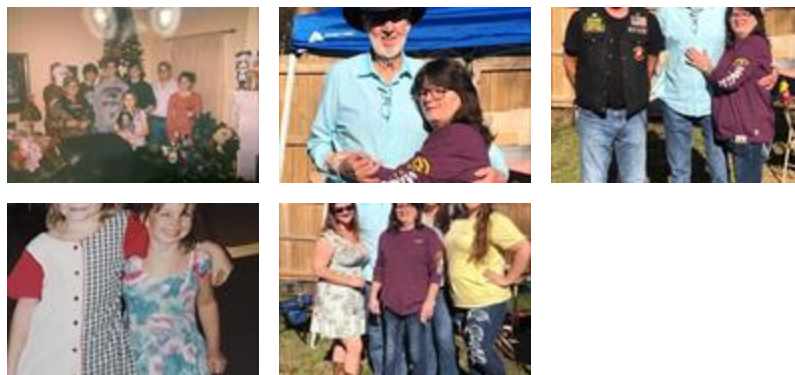
