Philip Oliver Correro, 86, of Hernando, MS, passed away on Wednesday March 27, 2024. 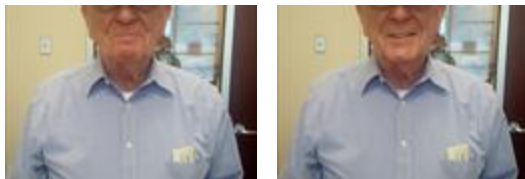
