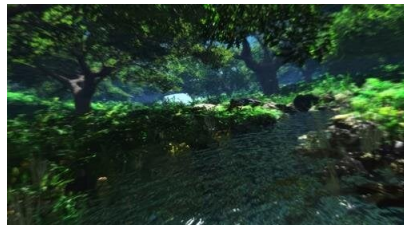

We went to auctions together and church. My Mom became terminally ill later on and we all started going to Trinity Baptist church together.

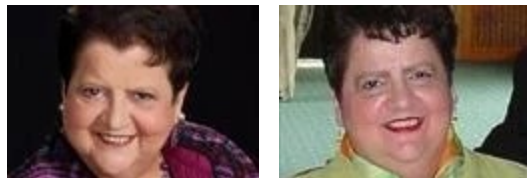
I am so grateful for that because it brought my Mom back to church.
