Sarah Herrien Kyser, age 86, died Wednesday, May 12, 2010 at Baptist Memorial Hospital, Oxford, MS.

Born in Tuscaloosa, AL, Mrs. Kyser had lived in the Oxford area for 15 years after moving from Tuscaloosa. She had worked as a registered nurse and a surgical scrub nurse during her career. Artistically gifted, Mrs. Kyser painted and did various types of needlework. She made uniforms for school organizations and dresses for pilgrimage tours in which she participated. Mrs. Kyser raised 80% of the money used to purchase the first Jaws of Life for this area with proceeds from her needlework. She was an active member of the Centennial Club, the Red Hat Club and College Hill Heights Baptist Church until her health failed.

A memorial service will be held Saturday, June 12, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. at Tuscaloosa Memorial Park. Coleman Funeral Home was in charge of local arrangements.

Survivors include a son, Doug Kyser and a daughter, Joy Kyser Kizziah, both of Oxford, MS; three grandchildren.

Her husband, Philip "P.J." Kyser, Jr. and her parents, Dewey and Johnnie Herrien, preceded Mrs. Kyser in death.
