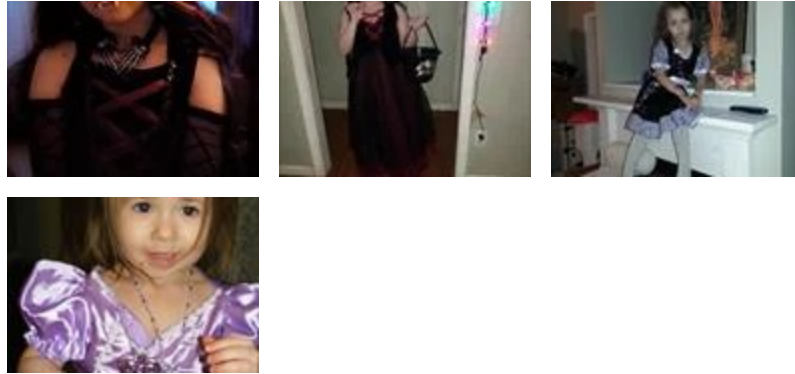

*Every year for Halloween, she got really creative with costumes.*

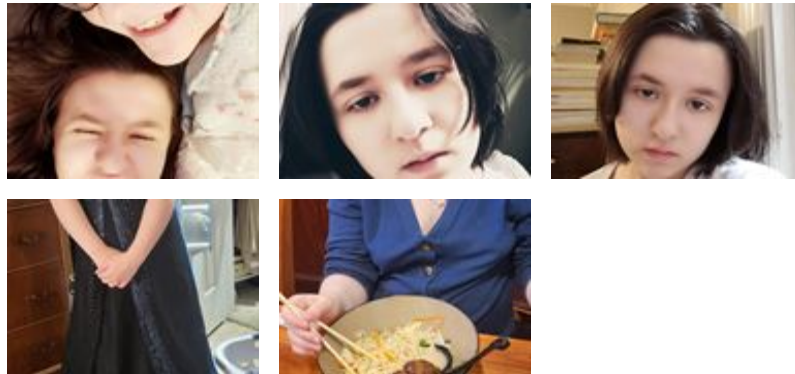
