Thomas James Bulian, 75, died Monday, July 23, 2012, at his home in Oxford, MS.

He lived in the Oxford area for approximately 25 years before he retired and moved back to Greece. While living in Greece, Mr. Bulian was a winemaker who owned his own vineyard. He was a member of the Greek Orthodox Church.
