The family moved to Nashville where he attended Central High School and stayed until 1964, when he was transferred to Florida by National Bronze Co. where he was a certified molder.

Vernon was preceded in death by his two brothers, Albert Troy Tines and William Dennis Tines.

He is survived by two sons, Vernon (Butch) Eugene Tines, Jr. (Janet) of Memphis, TN and Philip Alan Tines (Sharon) of Lebanon, MO and daughter, Terri Lynn Tines of Fletcher, NC. 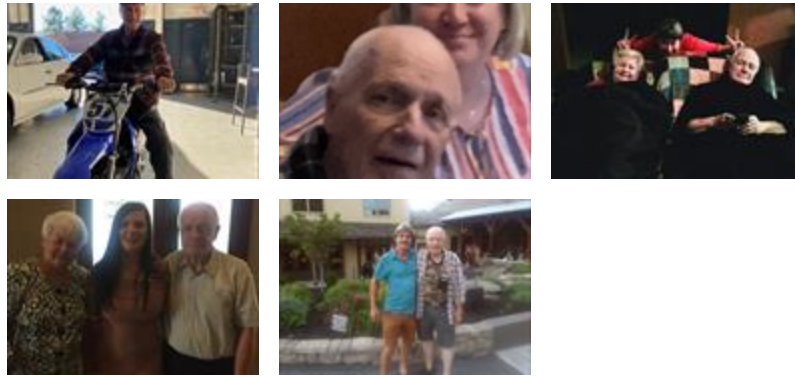
